COUNCIL CORNER

Update from Council Meeting — July 24th, 2018

- ⇒ Council held a **Committee of the Whole** session to hear general comments and feedback from the public.
- ⇒ Council voted for a **Development Variance Permit Application for 1641 Overlook Street, and one for 1045 1st Avenue West to proceed to public notification.**
- ⇒ Council voted for a **Development Variance Permit Application or 1053 1st Avenue West to proceed to final consideration.**
- ⇒ Mayor and Council approved the recommendations of the Director of Operations and Engineering firm Sperling Hansen to **award the Landfill West Berm Expansion project contract to Broadwater Industries.**
- ⇒ Council voted to support staff's application for **grant funding** through the ICIP – Green Infrastructure: Environmental Quality Sub-stream for **replacement of the submarine water supply line (Phase 3 of the waterworks project) and new water treatment facility.**
- ⇒ Council, in recognition of Councillor Kinney's long service to the City of Prince Rupert, **voted to dedicate the remaining gross value of Councillor Kinney's Council honorarium (otherwise budgeted for) to be donated to a Lung Memorial Clinic in Councillor Kinney's name.** If other community members wish to donate to the Lung Clinic, you may can contact North Coast Health Improvement Society via Judy Fraser at judy.fraser3915@gmail.com.
- ⇒ Council received **the May 2018 Financial Variance Report** for information purposes.
- ⇒ Council directed staff **not to include the applicants as presented for consideration in a permissive tax exemption bylaw amendment.**
- ⇒ Council gave **Third Reading to the Vehicle for Hire Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 3429, 2018**
- ⇒ Council **voted for a letter to be drafted by staff and sent to ICBC requesting that ICBC open a full time operation of a Claims Centre office within Prince Rupert or provide an adjuster several days a week to attend Prince Rupert rather than have the operations entirely centralized through Terrace.**
