Confidentiality

Your personal information is being collected for the 2015 City of Prince Rupert Go Plan Survey, and will not be used for any other purpose. The Go Plan Survey is intended to provide baseline data for the City related to population, housing, and planning for the impact of major projects. The collection of personal information is authorized by section 26(e) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. The enumerators involved in the survey have sworn an oath of confidentiality. The information you provide will be kept confidential and will only be used to produce anonymous statistics.
